



## **GENERAL INFORMATION – HIDE-A-WAY CAMP**

1. Each user shall be responsible to supply their own cooking utensils, mattresses, pillows, blankets, etc. The refrigerators and stoves will be available for users. Well water will also be available in the main lodge. Mops, pails, and brooms will be available at each cabin for clean-up. Garbage cans will be located at the cabins and main lodge. Each user is to ensure that all garbage is placed in proper plastic garbage bags and placed in the garbage container located by the wood pile building.
2. Consumption of liquor on site shall be in compliance with all Federal and Provincial regulations.
3. The Town shall be responsible to remove snow from the parking lots and roadway when possible and as time permits.
4. The Town will carry insurance on the buildings and the Town's contents. All users will be required to sign a waiver before using the facility and to be responsible for their own liability insurance in respect to programs being offered. Users are also responsible for their own personal contents coverage.
5. For the protection of the user, arrangements with the caretaker should be made for inspection prior to checkout. Keys should then be returned to the caretaker at this time.
6. With regard to Town Council appointed Boards such as F.C.S.S., Library, Tourism, etc. there shall be no charge for use of the main lodge for meetings. It is understood that there will be no use of the sleeping cabins.
