



RULES & REGULATIONS – HIDE-A-WAY CAMP

1. The maximum number of people allowed per unit shall be six (6) adults and not more than eight (8) people including children.
2. Check in time is 2:00 p.m. and check out time is 12:00 noon. Any variations to these times must be confirmed in advance with the caretaker.
3. Rental of the main lodge for day use shall be limited to a maximum of sixty (60) people.
4. All payments must be made at the Tourism Centre prior to occupying the facility. Keys will be given to your party by the caretaker at the agreed time of checking into the facility. Should you, or your party, be late a **\$20.00** per hour waiting time will be charged and deducted from your damage deposit.
5. All pets (dogs, cats, etc.) are to be on a leash. Any damage or yard mess is to be repaired or cleaned-up by the renter or it will be repaired or cleaned-up by Town staff and the cost will be deducted from the damage deposit.
6. Parking is permitted from the main gate area to the lodge only, except in the winter months when one (1) vehicle per cabin can be parked near or at the cabin for plug-in purposes. The roadways may be used to drop off supplies only (sleeping bags, luggage, etc.)
7. Motorhomes, trailers, etc. will be permitted to park along the main roadway between the main gate and the main lodge. These units are not allowed to be on the inside of the main lodge area.
8. Individuals are responsible for general cleaning, which will include sweeping of floors, garbage disposed of in the bags provided and put in bins, and chairs and tables in main lodge wiped down and stacked.
9. Open fires are permitted only in the firepit located on site. Use of the firepits may be prohibited by Alberta Forest Services.
10. No off-highway vehicles are permitted to be used on the trails or roads that are part of the Pierre Greys Lake Recreation area. Off-highway vehicles are allowed in and out of Camp Hideaway through the main road only. The off-highway vehicles may be parked on the cabin sites.
11. Cooking will not be allowed in any of the sleeping cabins.
