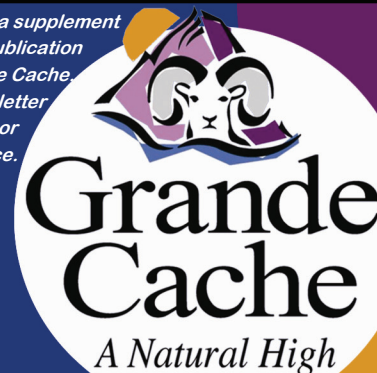

- Appliances: \$20.00
- Vehicles: \$150.00
- Snow machines, Quads, etc... \$25.00 per item
- Heavy Metals: \$20.00 for 1/2 ton truck load
 \$40.00 for 1 ton truck load
 \$75.00 for 3 ton truck load

 them curb side and they will be
 picked up accordingly.*
