- Illegal substances
- Camelpacks
- Pets (except for service animals)
- Baseball equipment
- Bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters or similar
- Motorized vehicles of any kind (quads, atv's, dirt-bikes, etc...)
- Fireworks

Other Stuff You Should Know

Can I get tickets at the Gate?

Subject to availability, there may be a limited amount of tickets available at the Gate. Once they're gone, they're gone so get them early!!!

Will tickets be cheaper if I show up only to see the last couple bands?

What time to gates open?

Gates open at 6 p.m. on Saturday and 6 p.m. Sunday.
