➤ **Festival Dates**

Friday, July 31st, Saturday, August 1st and Sunday, August 2nd.

➤ **Hours of Operation**

Friday 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

10:00 a.m. until the end of the concert on Sunday.

➤ **Application Deadline**

**Application Deadline to be included in our program is April 30, 2009.
The application deadline is Friday, June 5, 2009.*

➤ **Payment**

The application form must be accompanied by payment, if you require power, tables or chairs. Cash, cheque, or money orders will be accepted (please do not send cash in the mail). Cheques should be made out to the Town of Grande Cache.

➤ **Insurance**

The Vendor shall obtain and keep in full force and effect at all such times as the Vendor is participating in the Festival or has access to the Akasaka Recreation Centre, a comprehensive General Liability Policy with limits of **no less** than **TWO MILLION (\$2,000,000.00) DOLLARS**. A copy of the required insurance policy is due at the Town of Grande Cache before the festival starts.

➤ **Other**

- Vendors must be set up and ready for sales/presentation at 5:00p.m. on Friday.
- The perimeter fence must remain intact at all times.
- Recycling and refuse dumpsters will be on site. Vendors are required to transport and empty their own recycling and garbage into the provided dumpsters.

➤ **Power**

- All vendors must provide their own extension cords.
- 2 -15 amp circuits with 4-110V receptacles will be available for a cost of \$50. Additional power will be supplied for an additional cost if available. There will not be additional power for freezers, coolers or recreational vehicles. Please be prepared to use propane in your recreation vehicle.

➤ **Personal Services**

Personal services are defined as products or services that entail skin contact (hair clips, temporary tattoos, henna applications, skin creams, nail care, etc.). You will be required to complete a form detailing infection control for each

location. For booths where there may be multiple products, a form for each service must be completed. These products and services must adhere to the guidelines as set forth by the Alberta Health Services.

➤ **Space Boundaries**

Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, a Vendor may not extend the boundaries of its Site in any manner whatsoever unless it receives the written consent of the Town of Grande Cache. Site boundaries are restricted to the 15'x 15' designated area of the village.

➤ **Security**

There will not be site security at Deathfest 2009. All property of the Vendor at any time brought on the Festival site location or any part thereof shall be entirely at the risk of the Vendor.

➤ **Food Vendor Information**

All vendors that sell food for consumption to the public must obtain approval from Alberta Health Services to operate a Temporary Food Establishment. Application forms and information are available at the Akasaka Recreation Centre and with our Deathfest information at www.grandecache.ca, or please phone Peace Country Health at (780) 513-7519.
